

Due to the cooler weather, lunches will be distributed from the multipurpose room entrance. Park at the curbside stop sign, then walk to the entrance to receive your lunches. Please do not exit your car until you are first in line at the stop sign, and observe six-foot social distancing guidelines.



There will be no lunch distribution during Thanksgiving break. Lunch distributions will resume on Wednesday, December 2nd, 11am-2pm.

Effective immediately through June 30, 2021, all children, 18 years and under can receive FREE lunches, regardless of your income eligibility status.

Even though meals for children 18 years old and younger are free, we encourage you to complete and submit the **Alternative Income Form** (previously the Free and Reduced Meal application) as **this form drives important funding for our schools**.
