COVID Rules and Information as of 8/13/21

Currently, the following procedures are recommended by the California Department of Public Health in guiding the safe reopening of schools.

- Masks are mandatory for all indoors and optional outdoors, although highly recommended.
- 2. No physical distancing of desks are required.
- 3. Ventilation is key, either open doors/windows, or "air scrubbers" will be used.
- 4. Families are asked to use the COVID Factors Self Check daily.
- 5. If your child is ill, please keep them home!
- 6. Frequent hand washing and/or sanitizing throughout the day.
- 7. No parents on campus before or after school.



Important questions and answers from parents regarding COVID management:

- 1) Are there filters (hepa) in the classrooms? yes all rooms have hepa filters in the hvac systems additionally, each room is equipped with an air scrubber
- 2) Is my child's teacher vaccinated? We are not permitted to share this information
- 3) Will there be COVID testing on site and if so, how often and who will be tested? Yes, the District will have testing available 2x a week. Students who were close contacts will be tested. Currently staff are invited to receive tests weekly.
- 4) Will lunch be indoors ever, or always outside? Outdoors, unless rain, than in classroom
- 5) If we do home study, will our child be able to opt in to in-person any time? Will she lose his/her spot in the 22-23 year? You may opt into Homeschool program at any time, and if you

wish to return to a regular classroom setting it will be accommodated within 5 days, however, we cannot guarantee the placement will be in the same class or school.

- 6) Will all parents be alerted when a child tests positive from the child's classroom? yes
- 7) If parents choose to quarantine when a positive case is known in the classroom, will those days be counted as unexcused absences? we will offer a independent study program for quarantine period, there will be no unexcused absences counted
- 8) Are their protocols in place if there are close contact situations as well as positive cases? Yes, there is a COVID Management at School Flowchart that is in every office and is posted on the website. It explains scenarios for both the vaccinated and unvaccinated.
