

- If you are returning from distance learning to the 5 day a week model, you will be contacted by Friday, 4/16 with your teacher's name and contact information. Bell schedule for 5 day a week return:
- To promote social distancing, we are staggering Drop off and pick up time. Please refer to the chart attached to the newsletter. Students still need to remain in the car for temperature checks when arriving.

- •Please provide your child with a water container for the day. While we do have water stations to refill water bottles, drinking fountains cannot be used.
